The past month has been a busy time for the Club.

Congratulations to Gil and Pauline out our outright winners of the Club Pairs Championships. All pairs played one another by means of a Mitchell (week 1) and Interwoven Howell (week 2).

The Congress is now open for entries. Nearly 15% of the total entries available in the Swiss Pairs were claimed within five days, likely because an email was sent to last year's participants inviting them to return and play again. Teams in the Swiss Teams section may choose a team name if they wish with a possibility of a prize for the best name.

Tuesday and Thursday sessions continue to grow over the last five sessions there has been an average 12.4 tables per session. These sessions are a mix of players from seasoned bridge players to those that have come out of lessons this year.

Work has commenced on our programme for 2026. When the booklet is published, players will be asked to review pages 5 and 6, which cover Playing Conditions, Alerting Regulations, and Player Responsibilities.

The Swiss Teams Championships will take place in October, featuring fourteen teams, alongside our final Hi-Lo event for 2025.
